What is a "Parenting with Intimacy" Workshop?

An Intimate Life "Parenting with Intimacy" Workshop provides instruction and direct experience of biblical principles of relationships as they are applied to and experienced in families. Selected chapters of the Intimate Life resource *Parenting with Intimacy* are presented along with opportunities to experience biblical truth right in the session. This workshop will also equip participants in how to begin sharing the powerful principles they have received with others through on-going parenting ministry classes or small groups using the *Parenting with Intimacy* resources.

Grandparents who wish to really know and express love to their grandchildren, and appropriately support and love their grown children as well.

Single Parents will especially benefit from practical approaches to loving children that help make the most of their opportunities.

Couples anticipating becoming parents will be well prepared for the challenges of 21st Century family life.

Church staff and lay couples who desire to learn how to start and lead relational family ministry in their church. Hosting Requirements

Minimum of 50 paid registrants @\$25.00 per person (\$1250).

The cost for each person registered above the required minimum is also \$25.00, payable to ILM.

Pay for shipping of participant's materials. (This will be included on your invoice.)

Provide the facility within which the training will take place. The hours required are Friday night 6:00 PM 10:00 PM; Saturday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM. You will also need to provide the following.

1. Classroom-type seating for 60 – 80 people in comfortable chairs.
2. VCR and television/monitor
3. Overhead projector and screen

Cover Trainer expenses, consisting of:

1. Travel expenses for two. This will vary depending on home base of the Trainer team (\$400- \$500). *ILM will work with the Host Church to keep travel expense at a minimum. If projected travel expenses exceed \$500, ILM will contact the Host Church representative to discuss options.*
2. Friday night accommodations.
3. Intimate Life Ministries will pay the trainer the \$300.00 honorarium.
4. If you are interested in an Intimate Life Ministry staff member as your trainer, the financial arrangements are different. Contact the Workshop Coordinator 800-881-8008 ext. 213 for details.

Coordinate the Saturday luncheon. If lunch is made available on site, charge the participants appropriately (\$3.00 - \$5.00 is fairly typical). This can be an added relational experience and may work best on-site if there are not a variety of easily accessible restaurants where your guests can be served within the hour allotted for lunch. If there are nearby restaurants that fit this description, be sure to provide maps and/or directions in your handouts.

Review and sign Host Church Agreement Form and send with three possible workshop dates and \$250 non-refundable deposit to Intimate Life Ministries. Note: This deposit will be credited to Host Church account at conclusion of workshop.

Intimate Life Ministries will then confirm your workshop arrangements: your date and a trainer team. See the Galatians 6:6 schedule to confirm the dates the Sr. Pastor or another key ministry leader will attend a retreat.

Abide by the following Cancellation Policy:

- \$250 deposit is non-refundable, once ILM confirms your workshop.
- Host Church may re-schedule workshop. If workshop is re-scheduled, Host Church must compensate Trainer Team for any expenses incurred as a result of changing travel itineraries. ILM may be required to identify another Trainer Team.
- If workshop is cancelled, the Host Church will not receive a refund of \$250 deposit. In addition, Host Church must compensate Trainer Team*any travel expenses incurred.
- If for any reason *Intimate Life Ministries* cancels the workshop, the \$250 deposit will be refunded.

Though not required, we strongly urge you to consider providing childcare and appropriate meal options (even with a nominal charge) for your participants.

Agreement Form

"Parenting with Intimacy" Workshop

We have read and understand the Host Church Packet for the Intimate Life Ministries *"Parenting with Intimacy"* Workshop. We agree to the commitments required as a Host Church, specifically the following:

- Pay \$250.00 non-refundable deposit to ILM to secure workshop. (This deposit will be credited towards the final balance due.)
- Remit minimum registration payment of \$1035.00 two weeks prior to event. (50 people at \$25.00 per person less the 250.00 deposit plus \$35.00 shipping.)
- Registrants beyond the minimum 50 are \$25.00 per person and final payment for them is due the Wednesday after the conference.
- Include in 2-Day UPS envelope provided. Final payment due by the Wednesday after the conference.
- Contact ILM on the Monday after the conference with number of boxes of unused resources to call tag
- Pay for shipping of participant workbooks to the church.
- Provide the facility in which the workshop will be held.
- Provide the needed equipment specified for use at the workshop.
- Cover the trainer couple's travel expenses, paid directly to the couple.
- Arrange for Saturday's lunch for all participants.
- Abide by the Cancellation Policy as indicated below.

Cancellation Policy:

- ◆ \$250 deposit is non-refundable, once ILM confirms your workshop.
- ◆ Host Church may re-schedule workshop. If workshop is re-scheduled, Host Church must compensate Trainer Team for any expenses incurred as a result of changing travel itineraries. ILM may be required to identify another Trainer Team.
- ◆ If workshop is cancelled, the Host Church will not receive a refund of \$250 deposit. In addition, Host Church must compensate Trainer Team for any travel expenses incurred.
- ◆ If for any reason ILM cancels the workshop, the \$250 will be refunded.
